Registration: Register online at www.Bikereg.com/kankakee-krono. The race fee is \$40, with a discounted rate of \$20 for Juniors. Due to time constraints riders may only register for one category. Online registration closes at 11:59 pm, May 30th. Approximate start times will be provided after registration closes.

Number Pickup: Race numbers can be picked up at Pine Grove Campground on Boat Club Rd. in Aroma Park, Illinois, starting one hour before the first race.

Prizes: Medals will be awarded three deep in each category. Men and women as well as TT and Road Bike competitors will be placed separately. The Time Trial is open to all USAC licensed riders regardless of residency. Only Illinois Residents are eligible for state championship jerseys or medals. *Competitors in the Novice categories are not eligible for state championship jerseys.

Rules & Requirements: All USA Cycling (USAC) rules apply. Visit www.usacycling.org for details. Competitors must present a valid USAC license and submit a signed USAC standard release form at check-in. One-day USAC licenses (\$15) will be available for Juniors, Novice Men and Novice Women.

Helmets: CPSC-certified helmets are required at all times, including during warm-ups and cool-downs.

Course Conduct: The centerline rule will be strictly enforced. Littering—including water bottles and wrappers—is prohibited in parking lots and on the course.

General Conditions: Races will take place rain or shine. Though traffic is typically light, the course is open to traffic and riders are advised to exercise caution at all times. Riders must obey all Illinois traffic laws.
